The primary criteria for the Gordon and Suzanne Meth scholarship is that neither of the student's parents has completed a two-year(associate) or four-year(bachelors) college degree.

The primary criteria for the Rosemarie Ercolino scholarship is that the applicant resides in a single parent/guardian household.

Please ensure that you complete the application along with the required submissions and have your Faculty Advisor complete the Advisor Verification Form by **Sunday, February 8, 2026, at 11:59 PM.**

The All-Inclusive Scholarship Checklist

At the New Jersey District Education Conference, many scholarships will be awarded to the graduating class of Key Club Members. This year, it's all about the Class of 2026! To apply for scholarships offered by the New Jersey District of Key Club, follow these simple step-by-step directions. Use this as a checklist to ensure that you have completed all application components **BEFORE HITTING SUBMIT**.

- ☐ **Write a two-page max essay** about your most memorable Key Club Service Project. Be sure to explain the inspiration, the effort, the impact that the service project had, and the personal growth involved. The essay should be **12-point, Times New Roman, and double-spaced**. Then, upload the document to your application.
The essay should answer the following questions:
 - ☐ What was your most memorable Key Club service project, and why?
 - ☐ How did you become involved with the project?
 - ☐ What role did you play in the project, and how much time did you spend on it?
 - ☐ What was the most challenging part of the project, and why?
 - ☐ How did the project benefit the parties involved?
 - ☐ Did you meet your expectations?
 - ☐ What did you learn from this project?
 - ☐ How did this project affect you?
 - ☐ Finally, what would you tell other young people about your experience?
- ☐ Obtain **two letters of recommendation**: one from a teacher and one from another adult familiar with your community service efforts. NO LETTER may be from either a family member nor another student. *Both letters should focus on your community service work during high school.* Upload the recommendations to your application. If the recommenders do not want to share the letter with you, please have them email their letter directly to the Scholarship Committee Advisor (bsturm@njkeyclub.org) with your name as part of the email's subject line. Mrs. Sturm will confirm receipt.
- ☐ Ensure your advisor completes the **Advisor Verification Form**. Give the link below to your advisor for them to complete the form and the response will be sent directly to the scholarship committee. Link to advisor verification form:

- ☐ Upload and submit all of the above by **Sunday, February 8, 2026, at 11:59 PM. All documents must be uploaded as PDF or Word documents ONLY!!! Absolutely NO links to Google Docs will be accepted!!**
