
"ARTICLE XVII. NOMINATION AND ELECTION OF OFFICERS (10/25)

Section 5. A district shall endorse no more than one candidate for the office of president or vice president and ~~two~~ one candidates for the office of trustee. (10/19)"



"ARTICLE XVII. NOMINATION AND ELECTION OF OFFICERS (10/25)


Section 7. (D) (3) The conference shall next proceed to the consideration of candidates for the office of Trustee. ~~If the nominating conference so desires, these selections of trustee candidates to be submitted to the House of Delegates may include either none or both of the presidential and vice presidential candidates previously selected by the nominating conference, or both of either the presidential or the vice presidential candidates previously selected by the nominating conference. Hence, those dually nominated candidates' names shall appear on the ballot twice. The conference shall determine the number of candidates to be selected by it and submitted to the convention, provided, however, the number so selected and submitted shall be in accordance with one of the following options:~~




ARTICLE XVII. NOMINATION AND ELECTION OF OFFICERS

~~Section 7. (D) (3) a. In the case that no presidential or vice presidential candidates become dually nominated, the number so selected shall not be less than the number to be elected plus one and not more than the number to be elected plus three; or b. In the case that either the presidential or vice presidential candidates become dually nominated, the number so selected and submitted shall not be less than or more than the number to be elected plus three, for a total of 14 nominees; or c. In the case that all of the presidential and vice presidential candidates become dually nominated, the number so selected and submitted shall not be less than or more than the number to be elected plus five, for a total of 16 nominees.~~

~~4. If in the event that the candidates whose names appeared on the ballot more than once received at least a majority of votes in more than one office, the candidate would be elected to the highest office, and thereby forfeit their candidacy for the office of trustee.¹¹~~



“Article V: Officers


Section 1: The officers of the New Jersey District shall be a Governor, a Lieutenant Governors, a Secretary, a Treasurer, an Editor, a ~~Webmaster~~ and other non-voting members, and such other non-voting members as called for in these bylaws or policies of New Jersey Key Club.”



“Article V: Officers


1. **Section 4: (d) District Editor - The Editor shall edit, print, and distribute the official District Publication, The Jersey Key. The Editor of The Jersey Key shall be responsible for publishing as many issues of The Jersey Key annually, as may be determined by the District Board at its first District Board meeting, to such other persons and organizations as may be designated by the Governor. They shall further be responsible for obtaining new reports from the Lieutenant Governor of each division for publications in The Jersey Key. At no time and under any circumstances shall the editor of The Jersey Key publish any partisan or political material in the paper, so that The Jersey Key remains impervious to political influences. The Editor shall maintain the District’s various social media accounts, and post on these accounts.**

The Editor shall be tasked to maintain and update the official District Website with the most recent district news, announcements, events, and resources. They shall also improve upon the existing District Website, provide technological assistance when needed, and devise novel ways to utilize technology for the betterment of the district and its members. The Editor shall not be chosen by election but by appointment. The District shall receive applications for the position of Editor. The ideal candidate is chosen by executive decision between the District Administrator and District Governor, with final approval of the district board.



1. ~~Section 4: (f) District Webmaster - The Webmaster shall be a voting member of the District Board and shall be tasked to maintain and update the official District Website with the most recent district news, announcements, events, and resources. They shall also improve upon the existing District Website, provide technological assistance when needed, and devise novel ways to utilize technology for the betterment of the district and its members. The Webmaster shall not be chosen by election but by appointment. The District shall receive applications for the position of Webmaster. The ideal candidate is chosen by executive decision between the District Administrator and District Governor, with final approval of the district board.”~~




“Article V: Officers

1. **Section 5: All officers with the exception of the Lieutenant Governors, ~~Webmaster~~ Editor, District Chairs, and Lieutenant Governors-at-Large shall be elected at the annual district conference. Each Lieutenant Governor shall be elected at a division caucus held no earlier than December and no later than the District Conference.”**




"ARTICLE V. OFFICERS

Section 2. (a) A club shall endorse no more than two candidates for the position of Lieutenant Governor or for any given executive position for District Board office."




"ARTICLE V. OFFICERS

Section 4. (h) District Chair - A District Chair shall be appointed to the district board upon necessity. They shall carry out the programs and policies of the District Governor and of Key Club International within the District Board. They shall perform their assigned responsibilities as a member of the District Board."



"ARTICLE V. OFFICERS

Section 6. (x) Any board member who is officially removed from office as a result of disciplinary action shall be prohibited from seeking or holding any future elected or appointed District position, as well as any District-endorsed international position. This prohibition is permanent and applies regardless of the circumstances surrounding the removal."
